

First Nation gathering

Pehdzeh Ki First Nation (PKFN) will be holding its annual general assembly in Wrigley from Aug. 27 to 31.

The five-day meeting will include presentations on PKFN's lands and resources and protected area strategy, PKFN's community comprehensive claims process, and the band's financial report.

Presentations will also be made by a number of companies including Enbridge Pipelines Inc., **Devonian Metals Inc.** and Copper North Mining Corporation.

Drum dances or cultural activities are scheduled to take place each evening.

Following the assembly, PKFN is hosting a youth and men's handgames tournament from Aug. 31 to Sept. 3.

Youth aged 15 and under are invited to compete in the youth division and the men's division is open to males over the age of 16. Teams must include eight players and one alternate.

Cash prizes will vary according to the division with a first prize of \$8,000 in the youth division and \$18,000 for first in the men's division.
